Abstract of the contribution	This paper will review the legislative changes in legal recognition of gender identity in Portugal in the last decade. It will discuss the role of research and its application to practices in transgender health in the promotion of public policies anchored in evidence, as a means to advocacy. It will also outline how the Ministry of Health in Portugal, aligned with the Ministry for Citizenship and Equality, developed a Strategy for Health of LGBTI people, with a focus on transgender health and on intersex children and youth. Finally, we will present preliminary data on how trans people perceive their own health and the challenges faced.
